## **GENERAL RULES**

## Singles, BOYS, and GIRLS

There will be a total pinfall of 6 games; overall, 64 athletes will use 32 lanes, and the lane movement will be six lanes to the right for even numbers and six lanes to the left for odd numbers. Price fund we will as we have attached. Separate prices for Girls and Boys

## **Doubles BOYS and GIRLS**

There will be a total pinfall of 6 games; overall, 32 doubles will use 32 lanes, and the movement of the lane will be six lanes to the right for even numbers and 6 to the left for odd numbers. Price fund we will as we have attached. Separate prices for Girls and Boys

#### Team Event BOYS and GIRLS

BOYS and GIRLS will play in a 4team format (4 athletes per team)

There will be a total pinfall of 6 games. We will be 16 teams (10 boys and six girls), and we will use 32 lanes because we will line up each team in a pair of lanes. Girls will play between lanes 1 to 12 and move one pair of lanes to the right every game. Boys will move four lanes every game, even numbers to the right and odd numbers to the left, and they will play from 11 to 32. Price fund we will as we have attached. Separate prices for Girls and Boys

## **Master BOYS and GIRLS**

First Stage

#### **BOYS**

They will qualify the top 10 boys of All Events plus the best 2 athletes from Sweden, Czech Republic, Finland, Mexico, and Peru (in total 12) plus 8 of Qatar (we have 4 teams) in a total of 30 boys.

#### **GIRLS**

They will qualify the top 6 girls of the All Event, plus the best 2 athletes of each country, in total 12, will be in a total of 18 girls plus the 30 boys, they will have 48 athletes in total.

They will play a rhythm of 3 athletes per pair, using the 32 lanes, and the movement of the lane will be 6 lanes to the right: the whole group.

For this stage, all the athletes qualified will carry over 50% of the pinfall of the All Event (6 games of Singles, 6 games of Doubles, and 6 games of Team), and they will play 6 games.

# **Second Stage: Quarterfinals**

The top 12 Boys and the top 8 Girls of the First Stage of the Master they will play according to the following brackets; the top 4 Boys have a bye, so they qualify straight for the quarterfinals.
